## DETAILS FOR A CIVIL WEDDING IN RHODES

---

The bride and the groom -subjects of a European Union Country- are requested to supply the Municipality of Rhodes with the following documents:

1. Full birth certificate mentioning:
  - Name and surname
  - Father' s and mother's name
  - Mother's maiden name
  - Place and date of birth
  - Religion and nationality
2. Wedding license (Certificate of no impediment to marriage) issued by the registrar of the couple' s City Hall and translated into Greek and confirmed by the Greek Consul.

All foreign documents must be translated into Greek and accompanied by an "APOSTILLE" (Hague Convention of 5 October 1961/Convention de la Haye du 5 Octobre 1961).

Civil weddings take place in the City Hall of Rhodes every Wednesday and Friday afternoons.
